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Seminole Energy Services owns over 900 miles of natural gas gathering, has an interest in 16 midstream facilities, and 1 NGL rail terminal located in 6 states. Seminole Energy Services operates a 3 mile, 3" pipeline through Hawkins County Tennessee that transports natural gas liquids. Natural gas liquids consist of a mixture of ethane, propane, butane, and natural gasoline.

Seminole is committed to preventing all incidents, such as personal injuries, vehicle accidents, product releases, fires, and property damage. To ensure safe operation of our pipelines by providing the public, excavators, emergency officials, public officials, and other interested parties through increased public awareness and knowledge of our operations. Our Public Awareness and Damage Prevention Programs were developed to establish long term and mutually beneficial relationships with those who live or work near our pipeline. Seminole is a member of the "one-call" systems in every state in which pipelines facilities. "One-call" systems are designed to help the public,

contractors and others identify the location of pipelines prior to excavation to prevent damage to pipelines and protect the public. The leading cause of pipeline accidents is third-party damage caused by various types of excavation activities.

Seminole has emergency preparedness and planning measures in place in the event that a pipeline incident occurs. Seminole also works closely with local emergency response organizations to educate them regarding our pipelines and how to respond in the unlikely event of an emergency.
