WHO IS MID-VALLEY PIPELINE COMPANY?

Mid-Valley Pipeline Company (Mid-Valley) owns a 22" diameter underground crude oil pipeline. The pipeline system is operated by Sunoco Pipeline L.P.

The Mid-Valley system is approximately 1,100 miles long and traverses eight states. The pipeline is operated and maintained in accordance to industry standards and in accordance with regulations from the U. S. Department of Transportation.

Mid-Valley maintains a 24 hour Emergency Phone Number: 1-800-753-5531. There are trained individuals ready to assist in the event that a disruption would occur.

So what does a pipeline leak mean? It can mean danger! Besides all of the built-in safety factors and the best safety record in the transportation industry, pipeline leaks can and do occur. Escaping petroleum or product may be dangerous and warrants caution and immediate action once discovered.

What should you do if a leak occurs? Call your local police, warn others in the area, leave the area and notify the pipeline company by calling the toll-free number. Remember, the pipeline toll-free number is 1-800-753-5531 and can also be found on the line markers that mark the location of the pipeline right-of-way. This number is available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year and trained operators are ready to assist you.

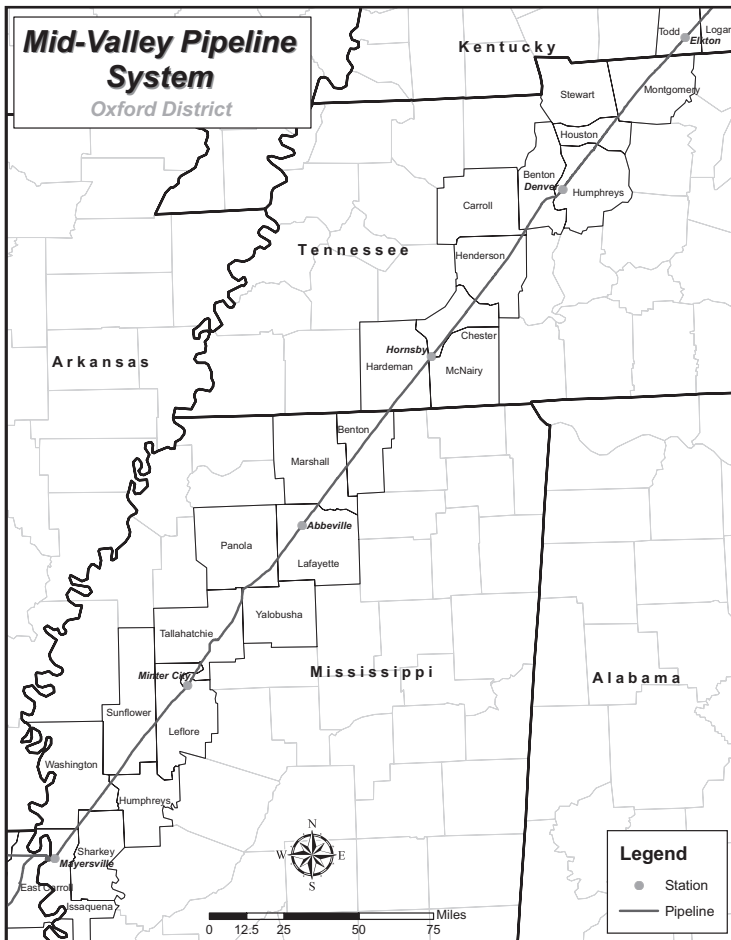
